TTI Testing is one of the leading companies in the field of inspection, testing services and forensic analysis for wire and fibre ropes, chain, electromechanical cables and related interface components in the onshore and offshore markets, and we have a strong commitment to excellence in all areas. Through our adoption of ISO 14001 and our environmental policy we wish to communicate our commitment to the protection of the environment, endeavouring to limit adverse effects in the environment in which it operates, ensuring that it meets all relevant compliance obligations and its operations are acceptable internationally. We are aware of the impact of climate change and the importance of making our operations as sustainable as possible so we can do our bit to mitigate this issue.

TTI Testing Limited's Management Team and employees are committed to running the business in such a way that will, as far as possible, prevent pollution and support environmental protection. This will be achieved by being aware of and implementing as far as possible the use of sustainable resources, to mitigate its effect on climate change as far as is practicable and to protect biodiversity and by the elimination or minimisation of waste and pollution, with due regard to all legislation, consents & controls. 
